Dear Parents/Guardians:

This letter is to serve as an important reminder regarding travel outside of New Jersey. If your child travels to/from or has had close contact with someone who has traveled to/from an area of high community transmission as indicated on the NJ travel advisory list (<https://covid19.nj.gov/faqs/nj-information/general-public/which-states-are-on-the-travel-advisorylist-are-there-travel-restrictions-to-or-from-new-jersey>) he or she must quarantine for 14 days from the last exposure. This means that your child cannot participate in in-person instruction and school sponsored activities during this time. He or she will however, be permitted to participate in virtual instruction during the quarantine period. A letter will be sent home to the parents/guardians indicating the return date for in-person instruction. We ask that you be on the lookout for the signs and symptoms of COVID-19 in your child through that date. Symptoms can include but are not limited to fever, cough, shortness of breath, sore throat, headache, diarrhea, vomiting and abdominal pain. Not everyone will get all these symptoms. In addition, if you believe your child has been directly exposed to an individual that tested positive for COVID 19 or your child has tested positive for COVID 19, please contact the school immediately.

Your local health department will also be in touch with additional information.

If you believe your child may have COVID-19, contact his or her primary care doctor for directions. Most people who are mildly or moderately ill with COVID-19 will be able to safely recover at home.

As always, we appreciate our community's support and cooperation. You can assist us by remaining vigilant but sensible in your approach to dealing with this health concern.
